the sovereignty and autonomy of the states to be neutralized and dismantled a ruling class has established itself in the halls of government diminishing the power of we the people and growing the power of an emerging oligarchy in america the rise of tyranny in america should instill in us a patriotic and revolutionary call to action we the people need to have the courage to take on the establishment and be informed enough to know how to do it without an informed populace carrying out their civic duty of keeping the republic how can the blessings of liberty be handed down to the next generation have we been experiencing such a steady decline in freedom that we have forgotten what liberty truly is how do we restore our constitutional republic especially at this stage in the game the founding fathers gave us a quiver full of remedies to combat tyranny all we must do is apply them during our advocacy to keep the republic it s not too late to save america the opportunity to keep
