don't want to cross i m micah the youngest member of resurrection if only they knew how young my fake id says i m twenty one and i will be in four years what can i say i blossomed early home sucked so i left determined to do something with my life landing the gig as lead vocalist in the band was a dream come true i've worked hard to make something of myself and nothing is going to ruin that for me then he showed up saxon waite ex bad boy of rock he's hot as hell and so into me but he's also twenty five i don't want to lie to him but if the truth comes out i'll lose everything including him fifty years ago the commander came into power and murdered all who opposed him in his warped mind the seven deadly sins were the downfall of society to punish the guilty he created the hole a place where sinners are branded according to their sins sinners are forced to live a less than human existence in deplorable conditions under the watchful eye of guards who are ready to kill anyone who steps out of line now lust wraps around my neck like thick blue fingers threatening to choke the life out of me i've been accused of a crime i didn't commit and the hole is my new home constant darkness brutal and savage violence excruciating pain every day is a fight for survival but i won't let them win i will not die in the hole i am more than my brand i m a fighter my name is lexi hamilton and this is my story with the passing of title ix a chicago high school girls basketball team becomes pioneers as they play for the championship in this sports memoir set against a backdrop of social change during the 1970s state is a compelling first person account of what it was like to live through both traditional gender discrimination in sports and the joy of the very first days of equality or at least the closest that one high school girls basketball team ever came to it in 1975 freshman melissa isaacson along with a group of other girls who'd spent summers with their noses pressed against the fences of little league ball fields unable to play entered niles west high school in suburban chicago with one goal make a team any team for missy that turned out to be the basketball team title ix had passed just three years earlier prohibiting gender discrimination in education programs or activities including athletics as a result states like illinois began implementing varsity competition and state tournaments for girls high school sports at the time missy and her teammates didn't really understand the legislation all they knew was they finally had opportunities to play to learn to sweat to lose to win and an identity they were athletes they were a team and in 1979 they became state champions with the intimate insights of the girl who lived it the pacing of a born storyteller and the painstaking reporting of a veteran sports journalist isaacson chronicles one high school team's journey to the state championship in doing so isaacson shows us how a group of tomboys found themselves and each other and how basketball rescued them from their collective frustrations and troubled homes and forever altered the course of their lives praise for state a beautiful story of basketball and life steve kerr head coach golden state warriors isaacson perfectly captures the birth of title ix and a time when high school girls were starting to gain equality in sports and in the classroom showing us how opportunities on the court can light a path for girls to become their authentic selves in all aspects of their lives billie jean king founder of the billie jean king leadership initiative the book is special because isaacson captures the special bond that formed among the female athletes not only were they teammates they were pioneers of a sort a wonderful book that is both eye opening history and a moving and deeply personal memoir booklist

has felt nothing but the overwhelming desire to end her life and she has no idea why we live to die so what's the point in living rose has pushed the limits in the past and pushed people away she can't figure out why jack and alex are so insistent on helping her twelve years of therapy has failed to help her so why should they be any different jack sees just how beautiful and important rose is but convincing her of that means putting his heart on the line something he isn't sure he can do he can't deny his feeling for rose but that doesn't mean he has to act on them and jack isn't the only one developing feelings for rose before rose jack vowed he would never let himself fall in love again before rose he had control but sometimes it's losing control that makes you really see what's really important in your life missy was one of 8 students in a prayer group who were shot by michael carneal on dec 1 1997 in the lobby of heath high school in paducah ky three girls were killed missy a 15-year-old sophomore at the time was paralyzed from the chest down but missy didn't see her disability as an end just hours after the tragedy she forgave carneal and took back her life in the next decade with no malice and a focus on her physical and mental rehabilitation missy would graduate from heath earn a bachelor's degree in social work from murray state university become a counselor for troubled youth get married and give birth to a healthy son missy now 26 has received numerous honors over the years for her determination and courage handmade style is a thoughtful collection of a variety of sewing projects to stretch your skills and keep you enjoying the process of creating throughout the year each project builds upon the other and is designed to help any sewist create a complete cohesive handmade simple and sophisticated look with the help of miss brooks missy's classmates all find books they love in the library books about fairies and dogs and trains and cowboys but missy dismisses them all too flowery too furry too clickety too yippity still miss brooks remains undaunted book week is here and missy will find a book to love if they have to empty the entire library what story will finally win over this beastly er discriminating child william steig's shrek the tale of a repulsive green ogre in search of a revolting bride of course barbara bottner and michael emberley pay playful homage to the diverse tastes of child readers and the valiant librarians who are determined to put just the right book in each child's hands this book is the stage version of e patrick johnson's sweet tea black gay men of the south an oral history a groundbreaking text for the fields of black studies queer studies and southern oral history and ethnography between 2004 and 2006 johnson edited a series of narratives from black gay men who were born and raised in the south and have continued to live there while the scholarly text of sweet tea has enjoyed wide circulation johnson knew that the stories of these individuals weren't able to come fully alive on the page he transformed the text into a theatrical performance which originally toured the country as pouring tea the oral history has also been adapted into a feature length documentary making sweet tea based on several tours and individual stagings sweet tea a play invites readers students theater practitioners and audiences from different backgrounds to engage with the lives of eleven men and one gender nonconforming person incredible characters all originally played by the author in a one man show standing on the balcony outside my boss's apartment wearing only my underwear not how i expected to start my saturday morning i guess i should've thought harder about going home with my sexy new gym instructor especially since i had no idea the guy was married when he pushed me outside five seconds before

his wife walked through the door i jumped one balcony over i thought it would be less embarrassing for a total stranger to find me than his wife that was a smart move so here i am wearing next to nothing and freezing my ass off staring through the living room window at my young sexy and very intimidating boss chase winston i have two choices i can sit here and try to think of another way out of this and risk dying of hypothermia or i can suck it up and knock on that window after a long internal argument with myself i choose option two here goes nothing
